The continuous upward spiraling of prices, taxes and wages has finally caught up with the United Telephone Company, which up to this time has withstood the 10-year trend of increasing costs, officials announce. The company operates telephone exchanges at Mill Hall, Beech Creek, Howard and Zion.

District Manager J. F. McCormick, in revealing that the company has filed a new schedule of rates with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, said: "There has been no general change in our local service charges for over 20 years, and in view of today's needs these rates have proved too low to assure adequate and dependable telephone service, combined with financial stability of the company."

In a letter to all United Telephone Company customers, L. R. Thurston, president of the company, set forth, that since 1950 operating expenses had increased 216%, while the gain in revenues for the same period was only 179%.
