AGAIN REVIVING.

Bishop Tuig for the Second Time Cheats Death—Last News Encouraging—A Great Preacher's Vitality.

Yesterday afternoon the following telegram from Father O'Reilly, Bishop Tuig's secretary, was received, indicating that the Bishop is not as sick as reported:

ALTOONA, May 11.—Bishop Tuig had a fainting spell last Saturday, but then he is steadily improving, and is able to sit up and walk through his room daily.

N. J. O'REILLY. This is the second time since Bishop Tuig's illness began that he has been given up for dying, and yet pulled through all right. He is regarded by physicians as a man of wonderful vitality. He is a Bishop revered by the clergy—beloved by all Catholics. When he became Bishop he found

the church property all over the diocese in rather bad shape. There had been many years of neglect, and the property of the times had led them to invest too much money in church property. They had gone into debt beyond their power to liquidate, and the new Bishop was forced to adopt stringent measures to overcome the error. He eventually succeeded, and although the means he employed were, at the time, considered harsh, Bishop Tuig in the end won the love and admiration of all his clergy. Bishop Domenech shortly after resigned his see, and retiring to his home in Spain died, venerated and respected by all his Bishop Tuig was then made administrator of the Allegheny diocese and bent all his energies to straighten the financial complications that had occurred. In December, 1882, heart failure and paralysis troubles rendered him unable to continue work. He took a journey South to Charleston, S. C., and returned apparently in good health. But the second day after his return, April 12, 1883, he was stricken again and was forced to retire to his home in Altoona.

HE HIT HIS HEART. A Bellevue Man Commits Suicide Near Altoona, Pa. Jacob Amalgam, a laborer, aged 38 years, committed suicide yesterday morning in Bailey's Grove, back of Altoona. The only friend living in Pittsburgh is his father-in-law, John Haddock, of Altoona, but he had not been at Mr. Amalgam's home, and it is not known when he came from Bellevue.

A man named August Held, while passing the grove between 7 and 8 o'clock yesterday morning, heard a shot, but took no notice of it. About 5 o'clock last evening Amalgam's body was found in the field with a bullet wound over the heart and a revolver still in his hand. The body was carried to Vierheller's undertaking rooms and Coroner McDowell was notified.

"Squire Barr was deputized to hold the inquest last night. Mr. Haddock testified that Amalgam had been married about ten years, but that his wife had not lived happily together.

The revolver found was a new 38-caliber gun. There was only one empty chamber. The jury rendered a verdict of suicide, and Amalgam's body will be shipped to Bellevue today for interment.

Amalgam was born and raised in Bellevue, and at the trial of Dukes for the murder of Captain A. C. Nutt, in 1884, he officiated as foreman of the jury that acquitted Dukes.
