TRUNK LINE ROBBERIES.

The Big Line Trouble Drifting Along Toward a Rate War.

CHICAGO, July 24.—The proposition of the Southern Pacific Railroad to guarantee the Canadian Pacific 6 per cent of the Pacific coast traffic and abolish its differential is considered by the Executive Committee of the Trans-Continental Association to-day.

The only agreement that could be reached was to recommend a reduction of the differentials, and a report to that effect was submitted to the general meeting, but the Southern Pacific refused to accept it.

To make matters worse, the Denver and Rio Grand eastern demanded a differential rate on Trans-Continental traffic on the ground that it is a narrow-gauge road.

This demand was referred to a special committee. No conclusion in regard to the matter under consideration was reached, and when the meeting adjourned it was to resume its deliberations at 10 o'clock to-morrow.
