PASSES AWAY AT BRUSSELS.

The Originator of the Ohio Idea and an Earnest Advocate of

THE PRESENT CIVIL SERVICE LAW. A Complex Figure in National Political History for Many Years.

Hon. George H. Pendleton, ex-Minister to Germany, died in Berlin Sunday night, of a stroke of apoplexy.

BRUSSELS, November 25.—Hon. George H. Pendleton, late United States Minister to Berlin, died in this city last night.

Returning home, he began the practice of the law at Sandusky, Ohio, where, after some time spent in study at Heidelberg, he traveled for three years, and was acquainted with languages, manners and men in all the chief capitals.

He was prominently spoken of by Speaker of the House, but Republican ascendancy prevented success in that direction.

AS A CIVIL SERVICE REFORMER. In 1871 he was President of the convention in which the Democracy of Ohio made the famous and successful platform and declared the acquiescence in the new amendments to the Constitution.
