AMOUNT TO BE RAISED.

This makes the estimated amount necessary to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the county for the year 1890 \$201,280.92. Added to this there will be \$100,000 to be placed to the credit of the workhouse managers for money used last year in reducing the debt.

A THREE-MILL TAX.

The suggestion of Controller Speer in his estimate was that \$300,000 be paid, but it was opposed by the Commissioners. The whole matter will be gone over in detail, but it is a foregone conclusion that the millage will not be more than 3 mills.
