

STREET CARS UPSET.

The Columbus Strikers Effectually Blockade Business.

ALL THE NEWS FROM NEARBY TOWNS

COLUMBUS, June 9.—The strike on the Consolidated Street Railway, which has been in progress seven days, culminated today in scenes which bordered on a riot.

The principal trouble the company has had was the failure to get police protection to start the cars.

RIOTOUS PROCEEDINGS. Shortly before noon, between 30 and 40 new men were moved to one of the cars in the east side where a crowd of several hundred had congregated.

The car was rocked back and forth, almost toppling it on the rails. The police did not get far from the car.

THE SECOND CAR DERAILED. It is estimated over 1000 people were crowded on the cars.

THE ORGANIZATION IS LEGAL. The action of the original incorporators sustains them at present.
