SPECIAL TELEGRAM TO THE DISPATCH. CHICAGO, June 16.—The gates to the great West were thrown wide open this morning when more than a 1,000 delegates and a number of members of the Junior Order United American Mechanics were given a hearty welcome to Chicago.
