

AT WAR UPON WOMEN.

Attempt to Prevent the Admission of Wyoming Territory as a State Because BOTH SEXES HAVE THE BALLOT.

WASHINGTON, June 26.—In the Senate today the House bill for the admission of Wyoming as a State was taken up and Mr. Jones, of Arkansas, addressed the Senate.

He declared himself in favor of the admission of Wyoming and of all the other Territories except Utah, when they had sufficient population and sufficient wealth to justify their assumption of State government.
