

REACHED THEIR GOAL

Over Four-Fifths of the Scholars Examined for the High School

STAND THE TOUGH TEST REQUIRED. Close Race Between Grant and Liberty Schools for First Honors.

THE O'HARA SCHOOL CROWDING THEM

Many a youthful heart in this city to-day beats lighter than it has for some time; but a number are quite cast down.

The result of the examination for admission to the High School was announced yesterday afternoon.

There were 602 candidates, and of these 418 passed; 20 failed in one study, while making the required average, and will be re-examined in the study in which the deficiency exists.

Twenty failed entirely, and eight did not complete their papers, on account of sickness.

There were more cases of illness this year than in customary, the hot weather being the cause.

These candidates will give a strong fight for the examination in September before the school opens.

The first honor was won by the Liberty School, where Miss Lida C. Astell made the remarkable average of 93.8 per cent.

The whole Liberty class did well, and as a class made a strong fight for the general average.

In this they were unsuccessful; the Liberty average was 83.3 per cent, while the Grant School made 88.8 per cent.

This, however, is not a slight consideration to the Grant. This district had the highest individual honor and the highest average.

There were 100 candidates for the first honor places as an unwise surprise. It is somewhat remarkable on the part of the Liberty School, as Miss Mary Anderson, its assistant principal and teacher of the High School class, has only held the post for one year.

The second honor went to the O'Hara school, where Miss Minnie Shilly had an average of 85.6 per cent, but 2-10 of 1 per cent less than Miss Astell.

The third honor was divided. Miss Bertha Young of the Liberty, and Miss Deborah Payne of the Grant, each making a record of 80 per cent.

High averages were the rule, 31 pupils making 90 per cent or better.

The fiscal year just closed has shown a very large increase in the business of the Pittsburgh postoffice.

In the mailing division there were distributed 20,572,000 letters, 297,589 of these being in transit and redistributed there.

This was an increase of 2,935,409 letters; 18,637,190 papers were distributed, 11,271,974 being second-class matter, newspapers and periodicals mailed by publishers and agents.

The total pieces of mail handled in this division amounted to 47,800,000, an increase of 4,112,000 over the preceding year.
