TOO MUCH RAIN. Buckskin Dick was the favorite in the third heat, selling for the best odds. Vaspasian, Present and Diok were lapped to the front quarter, all three whipping. At the present race, losing three lengths, Diok closed in on Vaspasian and they trotted together to the three-quarters, the rest being well up. Upon entering the stretch Keokos put on a burst of speed, and soon had the front ones in trouble.
