Physicians Examine a Child With a Remarkable Growth of the Brain. Dr. Meyer, McCann, McDonald and others made an examination yesterday of Clarence Dale, a 6-year-old boy, who has been exhibited throughout the country and is now in the city. The boy's head is remarkable for its size, being nearly twice as large as that of a normal child of his age. The physicians decided that it was not a case of hydrocephalus, but an abnormal growth of the brain, and the most remarkable case on record. The boy is bright, intelligent and cheerful in appearance, and enjoys being an object of interest.

Religious Know-Nothings.

A Logical Deduction to Prove That Agnosticism is a Contradiction. Dr. J. R. Sutherland preached last evening at the Second Presbyterian Church on "Know-Nothingism in Religion." During his discourse he said: "Usually men deplore ignorance. They make efforts to remove it. They are not satisfied unless they can know. You would conclude that ignorance was wrong if you heard a man say, 'I do not desire to know—I do not believe anyone can know.' Yet this is the man who actually goes on in their city that they do not and cannot know anything about spiritual truth. This they consider the highest mark of culture. The popular religion of those who think and study and are not agnostics is agnosticism. It is the last refuge of the skeptic. 'The agnostic settles that which, by his own philosophy, he should not settle—that which he cannot know. How does he know that does not know? What use is it to paint a house and brace it up when we know the foundation is built on sand? What use would it be to put iron girders in the top of a story if the bottom of the building is rotten.'"
