

THE SALARY GRABS. In Connection With the World's Fair Opposed by the Secretary of the Treasury. A PUNGENT LETTER FROM WINDOM. The Commission Must Go Very Slow in the Future in Making Use of the Funds of the Government, BUT THE LIST RELUCTANTLY ALLOWED.

CHICAGO, October 21.—President Palmer, of the National World's Columbian Commission, has received a letter from Secretary Windom, in regard to the expenses of the commission. The Secretary first states that of the \$1,500,000 appropriated, \$400,000 must be used in the operation of the Government building, leaving \$1,100,000 for other expenses.

CONCERNING SALARIES. In consideration of the foregoing showing of expenses, I have hesitated as to the propriety of the resolutions of the commission fixing the salaries of its officers, as described in articles 13 and 16 of your bylaws. The act of April 25, 1888, referred to by the Secretary of the Treasury and your commission jointly on October 15, will bring the total up to \$110,000, leaving only \$40,000 to run the commission on from that date till June 30, 1891.

RELUCTANTLY APPROVES THE LIST. The amount of money already expended and the expenditure contemplated by your commission prior to January 1 next, contemplated a large amount that it presents an additional reason why I should not approve the commission names, which I alone responsible for the expenditure.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS. Immediately after this communication was read before the Executive Committee, Commissioner Martin offered a resolution, which was adopted, declaring that all standing committees be instructed not to meet before the next session of the commission, unless directed by the President.
