RAW IRON AND STEEL.—The business in iron and steel for the month of June was remarkable in more ways than one. In the first place the sales were the largest ever made, during June, in the history of the trade. In another part of this report will be found figures for this statement. In former years dealers generally postponed purchasing until after July stock taking, but not so this year. Buyers for reasons no doubt satisfactory to themselves, particularly during the past two weeks, purchased several large blocks of Bessemer pig and cast iron. This was not confined to Pittsburg alone. The Mahoning and Shenango valleys, and other points from which Pittsburg sometimes obtains supplies, were making large business, and are undoubtedly well pleased with the situation and outlook. The stock of iron for sale here is not a large one, but, certain quantities are being sold at present. This certainly shows confidence in the future.

The Cloud Not Very Dark.

The annual meeting of the Amalgamated Association is in the main the same as the scale for last year, but a few apparently insignificant stipulations which have been added to the constitution are of considerable importance. A well-informed party has this to say: "Probably the most serious obstacle in the way of improvement is the fear of slight monetary fluctuations in the months. This is shown in the limited demand for rails and other equipments. Prospects are not very bright, especially in a large carrying business, as abundant crops are now assured, and many tools were never needed. The outlook for rolling stock is not as bright as at present. There is a feeling among holders that the market will shut down for a short period July 1 to take stock and adjust the cost of wages. This is a possibility, but these matters are completed an active demand and improvement in prices of all kinds of raw materials is predicted, will soon take place.
