There have been, all told, about 155 loads of cattle on sale this week at the East Liberty yards. Last week the total was 130 or thereabouts. The quality of this week's offerings was below last average and this is putting things pretty strong, as the complaint all along has been that prime beefers are comparatively scarce.

Chicago—There was another boom in wheat today and another advance in prices was scored. The early news was nearly all of a bullish character. A foreign crop announcement gave estimates of the world's wheat crop, which made the total yield of the year 50,000,000 bushels short of the comparative demand. Paris cables reported a decline in the price of wheat in France on flour, based on late Russian figures and the fact that the French crop is turning out worse than expected.

Wool Market.—The market opened quiet, and for the first time in several months the selling seemed inclined to weaken. For a time the price advanced about 10 cents per pound, but then it fell back to the level of the previous week.
