

A BEARISH REPORT. There is a Marked Increase in Oil Work for the Month of July.

The Buckeye Field Also Comes to the Front With Plenty of Oil. QUIET IN THE FIELDS YESTERDAY

The work for the past month in the oil fields shows an increase all around. In new production there is an increase of 1280 barrels, and an increase of 30 completed wells over the number reported for June.

There is a marked increase in the number of rigs being drilled, and a decrease of 62 rigs. This is largely due to the opening of the McDonald field, where rigs were thrown up rapidly during the latter part of June.

Notwithstanding the drilling that is now being done the average production of the month was only 17 1/2 c. In the southwest district there are 43 more new wells being drilled now than in June, but a decrease in rigs. There is a decrease in drilling in Bradford, Allegheny, Venango and in only three in the middle fields.

Altogether, the outlook for better prices in the Pennsylvania districts is not encouraging, looking from the present report. The number of rigs on the oil fields, and as long as the situation remains as it does at present there are few prospects of an increase in the production of oil.
