NEW WELLS DRILLING.

There is Great Activity All Along the Big Southwest Pool.

PRODUCERS ARE BUILDING TANKS.

Many Wells Show the Gordon Sand Level Next Week.

BIG GASSEY IN INDIANA TOWNSHIP.

Outside of the McDonald field there is practically no shut-down work as about 200 wells are being drilled. The well on the Miller farm, which was increased to 200 barrels an hour by deeper drilling, was doing 120 barrels an hour yesterday. Their Nos. 3, 4, and 5, on the same farm are being cased, and their Nos. 6, 7 and 8, on the Miller are each down about 1,000 feet. They were started this last week, and the production of several of the old ones was increased to enormous proportions. The oil that escaped for a few days would have made a nice addition to the bank accounts of the owners if it had been corralled. Contracts have been made for the erection of a couple of 25,000-barrel tanks. One of these will be located on the Elliott farm and will be owned by Guffey, Murphy & Co. Other operators are talking of combining and putting up tanks.
