Our Trade Largely Increased During the Past Eleven Months BY THE M'KINLEY BILL'S ACTION.

THE GOOD EFFECT OF RECIPROcity.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 10.—The Bureau of Statistics of the Treasury Department has made public a report of great value upon the foreign commerce of the United States for comparative periods under the old and new tariffs.

\$41,206,425.49, notwithstanding the large increase of imports. The principal article of our imports from which the duty was removed is sugar, and by the provisions of the tariff law the removal of this duty did not take effect until April 1, 1891.

During the 11 months ending August 31, 1891, the value of our exports was \$53,210,367, an increase of \$74,768,639 over the value of our foreign commerce during the prior corresponding periods.
