They Must Preach the Gospel With Their Mouths Clean.

BAD EXAMPLES SET FOR THE BOYS.

The Colored Ministers Draw the Line Rigidity at Tobacco.

A RESOLUTION WHICH WAS NOT A JOKE.

The colored clergymen of Pittsburgh and Allegheny are starting a new reform. They have drawn the line at tobacco. Beyond that, ministerial indulgence may not go. A month ago the annual conference of the A. M. E. Church in this section of the country was held in the sanctuary on Hemlock street, Allegheny. The following resolution was introduced by Rev. John W. Reilly on behalf of the Committee on Temperance:

Resolved, That every member of this conference be given six months to quit the use of tobacco, so that we may be able to preach the holy gospel with clean mouths. The resolution was adopted. One month out of the six has now passed, and a reporter of THE DISPATCH started out to see if the terse threat—for it is an implied threat—has had the effect of decreasing the consumption of tobacco among the preachers.

"Was it all a joke?" he asked Rev. Cornelius Ashbury, whom he met at the colored church on Wylie avenue, a short distance above the Court House.

"No, sir, it was not a joke," replied the clergyman. "The resolution meant exactly what it said. Why, sir, Bishop Arnett, who presided at that conference refused to license any of the new preachers who then applied unless they pledged themselves to abstain from the use of tobacco. He waited for the reply of each applicant, and they all had to promise."

The preachers will be watched. "And I am going to watch to see that these pledged preachers keep their promise," interrupted Rev. Mr. Sampson, who was standing in the room into which he had just entered. "Why, sir, you don't matter will be attended to at the next annual conference."

"Will the resolution be remembered by the conference next year in so far as to make inquiry about its compliance among all preachers, both old and new?"

"Undoubtedly," replied both the preachers almost in the same breath. Continuing, Rev. Mr. Ashbury said: "It is the custom of our conference every year to vote on this question. The moral effect of repeated utterances on the subject has been good, and I may say to you that comparatively few of our colored preachers use the weed. The resolution this year was plainly worded, and I have no doubt that inquiry will be made next year as to how many of us quit the use of tobacco."

The Bishop holds very strong grounds on this question. "The Bishop holds very strong grounds on this question," he said. "I was evidenced by his having the young candidates for the ministry promise to let cigars, the pipe and the quid alone. I favored the adoption of this resolution at that conference, and I hope it will do much good. We ministers cannot afford to be smokers or chewers."

He can set boys to smoking. A colored minister from a suburban town said: "I can set more boys to smoking cigars in my village than any other man who lives there. How? Why, by simply walking down the main street smoking to myself. I am their pastor—supposed to be to them the embodiment of all that is clean, pure and right. If I thus publicly smoke, they will see, and they will do as I do. I don't see it. It is the example that we set. No minister ought to smoke or chew for this reason, if for no other, and there are other reasons of course."

One other city clergyman, of the A. M. E. Church, did not favor the method taken by the conference of dealing with this question. He said tobacco was largely a personal matter with preachers. "Why, sir, you are sensitive about it, and would probably decide the man who had courage to pose as a sincere reformer in this respect. Perhaps, after all, though, it is better to avoid formalism in such a delicate matter, and rely upon a general raising of the tone of the church for the same good results. In this way offense would be averted, and the practice of questionable domestic habits quietly and discreetly changed. It is when a smoking preacher goes to a congregation where cleanly parishioners from upon his habit, he will find it out in a more severe way than his brother preachers can tell him of it. Still, if our colored brethren are in earnest about this matter, it will set a conspicuous example to the white ministry."

YACHTSMEN HELD AS SMUGGLERS.

An Unpleasant Happening to a Pleasure Craft Party in the Port of Honolulu.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 19.—A letter received in this city from Honolulu reports that a great sensation has been caused there by the arrest of the owners of the British yacht, *Beagle*, who were charged with smuggling 200 cigars. The yacht, which contained Messrs. Bloom and Douglas, the owners, and a young man named Joseph Byrne, arrived in the harbor. The party rented a fine residence, furnished it handsomely and entertained royally.

On the arrival of the steamship *Australia* from the colonies came a detective and a story of the robbery of a bank at Sydney on the possession of Marshall Wilson, which tallied with the appearance of one of the parties here, and led to the *Australia* for San Francisco, for the purpose, as he said, of enabling to Sydney for further instructions. It was the intention of Bloom and Douglas to spend a few months on the island, but they suddenly changed their minds and prepared to leave November 5. As soon as the clearance papers were given, a charge of smuggling was prepared against the men, and they were placed under arrest. At their trial the Crown asked for further time, requesting their detention until the steamer arrived, which would bring the detective or the desired evidence. The cabin of the yacht was searched, and no contraband was found. Being unable to maintain the charge of smuggling the Crown dismissed the case against the owners, and they sailed away on Monday. Their destination is said to be Japan, but it is intimated that they will touch at San Francisco.

THE TOWN LOT WELLS.

In McDonald Have Been Disappointing to the Operators.

SOME CHANGES IN THE SITUATION.

Mellon's No. 5-Neely Reported Big, and the Walker Well Small.

BIG PIPE LINE RUNS FROM THE FIELD.

There has been a decided change in the tune of the operators in the southwestern end of the McDonald field within the past 15 days. Most of the town lot wells have been completed, and not one in 20 have come anywhere near the anticipations of the owners. The whole aspect of the field in and around the borough has been one of disappointment. Where many were called to the field by the prospect of big wells, disappointed operators would now be willing to take almost any price for the exceedingly small wells which they have drilled. For a time it looked as though the town lot ventures might be profitable, but the lagoon were the big Miller and Mevey farm wells, and directly southwest were the big Cook lot and the Sauters wells. Further to the west were the Butler lot, the Short lot and the Royal Gas Company's No. 3 Sauters. Jumping at the conclusion that these wells were all connected, and that the belt was under the borough, scores of men who could ill afford to leave town and incur the expense of drilling, were induced to do so. The result has been that they have now to get down wells on their leases. As a consequence there was scarcely a back yard in the whole town that did not have a well in the ground. The Run from the Field. The runs of the Southwest Pipe Line Company from the McDonald field Wednesday reached the unprecedented amount of 120,187.08 barrels. Outside of McDonald there were 34,897.75, and the shipments were a total of 155,084.83 barrels for the day. There were 72,000 barrels of stock in Greendale & Forst's iron tanks, which were transferred to the pipe line company, and the general production fell off yesterday to about 60,000 barrels, a reduction of 2,800 barrels. The National Transit runs yesterday were 34,897.75, and the shipments were 1,833.55; and the shipments of the Southern Pipe Line Company were 9,298.15 barrels.
