A Russian Invents a Mysterious Compound to Do to Death

AUSTRALIA'S MYRIADS OF RABBITS

Millions in It if His Expectations Are Fulfilled.

EXPERIMENTS MADE IN ALLEGHENY

For years past New South Wales has been plagued by swarms of rabbits which have caused incalculable damage to land and financial loss to the country.

There have been numerous devices and poisons used in the agricultural districts of Australia, but none has been found absolutely effective and safe.

The exterminator of which Mr. Naftaly is the possessor is not necessarily a poison, and furthermore will only be eaten by animals which gnaw, such as rats, squirrels, rabbits, etc.

The great feature of "Crissomere" is that horses, cattle and swine will not eat it, as has been demonstrated by numerous tests.

The Colony of Sydney has since 1887 offered \$25,000 to any person who will successfully exterminate the rabbits of that country without danger to other useful animals.

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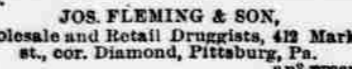
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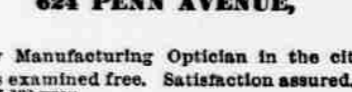

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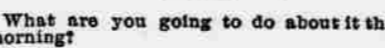
