HOG MEATSKYWARD.

A Continuation of the Excitement of Wednesday—Only a Light Trade in Wheat at Previous Prices—Contract Grading of Corn Improving—Oats Quiet.

CHICAGO—Excitement centered in provisions. Pork opened 7 1/2 @ 100 higher and then advanced 30c on liberal buying by the speculators. As soon as the demand subsided there was a reaction of 15c, and then another bulge of 10c on buying orders coming in from the country. The market fell off 50c later on, and then, under the influence of the strength in grain and liberal buying by a prominent packer, institution, advanced about 15c, the highest point of the day. This was followed by a decline of 20c, a reaction to a like extent, and a similar falling off, the closing being 2 1/2c higher than at the same time yesterday. Lard gained 7 1/2c and closed strong, seemingly independent of other hog products, and was more in request than for some time past. Rib-opens at the final figures of yesterday, and then advanced 10c, the reaction to the strength in pork and close buying reacted later about 7 1/2c, and closed 15c higher than yesterday.
