PANKO MEN BELIEVE AN INNOCENT OF EVER SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS. LATE NEWS GATHERED IN THREE STATES

SPECIAL TELEGRAM TO THE DISPATCH. COLUMBUS, June 23.—Between the hours of midnight to-night and 3 o'clock to-morrow morning Jacob Harvey, the Dayton murderer, will be hanged in the Ohio Penitentiary for the murder of his mistress.

Only one request has been made by the condemned man. This he did Wednesday afternoon in a communication to the Deputy Warden requesting that the Deputy Sheriff of Montgomery county be allowed to witness the hanging which request was granted.

Preparations for the final event have been all completed. Deputy Warden Playford says that the law governing executions will be rigidly complied with in this case.
