TOLD IN ANNUAL CONVENTION.

A Strong Report Against Sunday Opening of the World's Fair.

CONGRESS SOLEMNLY APPEALED TO

New York, July 7.—The eleventh International Christian Endeavor Convention, which opened this afternoon in the Madison Square Garden, promises to be the largest religious conference ever held in this country. Up to noon today over 10,000 delegates from out-of-town societies had arrived here, and nearly half as many more are expected by the afternoon and evening trains, while the New York societies will probably have about 7,000 representatives.

The convention opened at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon with prayer and praise service. Following this came the address of welcome from New York pastors, Rev. Dr. Charles F. Deems, of the Church of the Strangers, voicing the welcome. In closing his address, Dr. Deems said:

During the lifetime of our young society, the question of Christian union has attracted more interest than ever before since the Reformation. The ecclesiastical projects have all been cold, faulty, pragmatical and impracticable schemes, working from without and binding people together with eternal cords.

An effective movement without form. This work has been more effective than all other things combined, because it has been spontaneous, without plan or purpose, unworried, spiritual and Christly.

The address of welcome from Brooklyn pastor was delivered by Rev. A. C. Dixon, D. D. The response to the address of welcome, in behalf of the Board of Trustees of the United Society of Christian Endeavor and the delegates present, was given by Dr. Merrill B. Gates, of Amherst College. Rev. Mr. Pratt, pastor of the Williston Church, Portland, Me., addressed the conference, saying his church is the birthplace of the first Christian Endeavor Society and he is the bearer of the greetings of that mother church to the multitude of Christian Endeavor societies throughout the world now assembled in convention.

Mr. Pratt concluded by presenting to President Clark, Chairman, a gavel made from the pulpit and corner stone of the Williston Church. President Clark accepted the gavel in a brief speech.

The annual report of General Secretary James stated that the reported number of societies was 21,000, while there were others not yet recorded that would bring the total up to 22,000. Last year, at the Minneapolis convention, the reported number was 16,274.

Divided Among Seven Sects. The total number of societies covers 30 denominations, with 4,700; Congregationalists, 4,600; Baptists, 2,700; Methodists, 2,300; Disciples of Christ, 1,500. The total membership is 1,370,200. New York leads all States in territory and provinces in the number of societies, having 2,532. Pennsylvania is next with 1,828; Illinois third, with 1,600; Iowa sixth, with 1,024.

There are in America 1,377 societies, an increase of over 500 during the past year. The five provinces having the greatest number of societies are: Ontario, 830; New Brunswick, 388; Quebec, 371; New Brunswick, 371; Massachusetts, 371; West Indies, 12; Samoa, 9; Africa, 9; China, 9; Japan, 6. The total from foreign and missionary lands is 648.

The report of the committee appointed at Minneapolis last year on Sunday closing of the World's Fair was read by Rev. E. V. Hunter, of Terre Haute, Ind. Previous to doing so, Dr. Hunter said: "There are some who want the World's Fair open on Sunday. Do we want it open? A mighty shout of 'No' was the response. Dr. Hunter then read a paper, which formed the committee's report, in conclusion, the committee made the following recommendations:

Second—That we call upon the authorities to forbid the sale of intoxicants on the Exposition grounds.

Third—That we urge Congress to exercise its prerogative by passing a joint resolution instructing the United States Commission to close the entire Fair on Sunday.

Fourth—That the Chairman and Secretary of this convention be requested to telegraph the following to the President of the United States Senate:

STABBED HIS COMPANION.

Thomas Pringle Plunges a Knife into Alex. McQuinney's Back.

A cutting affray took place on the Morning side road, two miles from Sharsburg, Wednesday night, which may result in a murder. Those mixed up in the affair are two boys not yet 17 years of age, Thomas Pringle and Alexander McQuinney. They are next door neighbors and have always been good friends. Wednesday night they got into a quarrel over a game of ball, a scuffle took place and suddenly Pringle broke loose from McQuinney, drew a large penknife from his pocket and plunged it into McQuinney's back between the shoulders, inflicting an ugly and dangerous wound. Pringle ran and McQuinney was picked up and carried into the house and Dr. Robinson, Sharsburg, summoned.

Dr. Robinson dressed the wound, and thought the case so serious that he reported it to the police at the Seventeenth ward police station. Police Captain Richard Brown at night went to Morgantown and arrested Pringle and brought him to the Seventeenth ward police station. An information will be lodged against him, and he will be given a hearing Saturday.
