New Trial Asked for George Strasser, Convicted of Murder. JUDGE EWING ON HUMANAGENTS.

Two Cleomargine Dealers Lose Their Votes This Fall.

MARCHING CLUB DISASTER IN COURT

Attorneys W. A. Hudson and J. M. Friedman yesterday filed their reasons for asking for a new trial in the case of George Strasser, who was convicted of murder in the first degree for the killing of Joseph Brandt.

Before Judge Ewing J. K. Dain was tried on a charge of cruelty to animals. The case resulted in some pertinent remarks by the Court directed at the agent of the Humane Society.

Judge Ewing's Caustic Criticism. There was but little in the case, and Judge Ewing remarked that there were many of these so-called agents who are poor judges of law and justice, and go around seeking against whom they may bring charges in which there is neither law nor justice.

W. C. Staving and Albert Braun, dealers in the Allegheny market, were each fined \$500 and sent to jail for selling cleomargine.
