### CONGRESSMEN RILED

By the Emphatic Editor of the Organ of the Eastern Coal Trade.

NEW YORE, Nov. 28 .- The Congressional sub-committee investigating the anthracite coal combine examined witnesses here today, with the usual result. President Oil-phant, of the Delaware and Hudson, declined to answer questions as to prices, but said the retail coal business was a poor one now. Another witness admitted that the circular prices were fixed by the Tidewater and Western meetings, but were not always adhered to.

F. E. Sayward, editor of the Cool Trade Journal, when sworn as a witness, remarked that he hoped the committee would ask him some intelligent questions so he might be able to give some intelligent answers. He had not heard any intelligent questions asked yet, be said. "Now let her go," said Mr. Sayward.

Mr. Sayward. Congressman Wise caused Sayward to somewhat modify his manner by requesting him to conduct himself with some degree of propriety. Witness said his paper contained what purported to be a correct list of prices.
