

One Month Later from California!

Since the inauguration of Gen. Taylor, on the 4th of March last, notwithstanding his solemn pledges against proscription, we find, in the New York Herald, that not less than twelve thousand removals have been made! Of these, 4,000 were in the Post Office Department, 4,000 in the Home Department, 4,000 in the Treasury Department, and over 1,000 in other Departments. Such wholesale proscription and banishment for office, has never been witnessed under any other Administration, since the first establishment of the General Government!
