**Management of Bees.**  
As the days become longer, and occasionally more mild, bees require extra care. They will come out on warm days, and become chilled by cold winds, they will fall upon the snow and perish, they are suddenly affected by the cold snow, and cannot recover.

The most simple mode of preventing this evil is to shade the hives, then the bees will usually keep within, until it is warm enough for them to go out. Large without danger. In a warm location, the sun will often strike with a considerable force upon a hive, which, with the natural heat of the warm, will make the hive so warm they are unable to endure the cold wind.

Without regard to the loss of bees in this way, it is far better to keep them shaded in winter, to avoid the extremes between cold nights & the warm sun of the day. By keeping them in an equilibrium of temperature, as far as possible, the bees will be in a more healthy state, and as they will be dormant, they will consume less honey than will be required when they are occasionally active.

By very exact experiments, in weighing bee hives weekly, we have found that a swarm would consume honey much faster in July or August, in time of severe drought, than the flowers afford no honey, than in the coldest months of winter.

We have put-fable swarms of bees that had only a few pounds of honey, into a cellar early in winter, and let them remain till spring, when the weather was sufficiently warm for them to go abroad, and the difference in the weight of the hive, at the time of putting it into the cellar and taking it out, was not perceptible without weighing.

Bees require attention, but they are often neglected. A friend of ours had several hives of bees, early in the winter which he put into a closet in a central part of the house, where the temperature was nearly even, and they were all in good condition in the spring. The same season, another friend had six hives, which stood out in a shed, open to the south, exposed during the winter to occasional hot sun, cold winds, and the most rigorous cold by night, and one extreme of cold following another in rapid succession. The consequences of this imprudence was a loss of one half of the swarms.

**Matters to be Attended to Now!**

We copy from the American Farmer, the following excellent hints to be taken now by every farmer. They are good, practical suggestions, such as apply to the duties of every one, and if followed, must have a beneficial result.

**Care of Manure.**—We have so often called the attention of husbandmen to these matters on their farms calculated to be converted into manure, that it is not necessary to point out what is susceptible of being converted into manure, but we will here admonish them to be most diligent to go to waste that is of that character; and it may not be amiss to state that their cattle, barn yards, and other places where their stock may be kept, should be so shaped as to prevent the riches of their dung being the legal points of it, from being washed away, and we would impress this truth upon their serious consideration, that if it is neglected and preserved, it is worth two to which is now attention has been paid.

All manure before being hauled out, would be greatly improved by having one basket of plaster mixed with every twenty loads of it.

**Face Sides.**—If your face sides are infested with growing bushes, brambles and briars, cut them down, and root them up. You may take your work for it, that such encumbrances, while they exhaust the soil and the fence, never fail to ruin for those who tolerate their growth an unweary name—the stranger who may pass your farm will see such evidences of neglect invariably make the invidious remark—see there's a slovenly and negligent farmer.

**Fields untenanted by Crows.**—If the ground you intend to put in corn next spring, is a clover sward, mow and plough it up deeply, leave it until just before you are going to plant your corn, then mow it until you get it into fine furrows. This done so on each acre of it two bushels of salt hallow it in, roll, and plant your corn; and you will experience but little annoyance from grub and other worms, as the salt will give them their quietus just as notably as though you had done it with a bocklin.

Besides this, the salt will, to a considerable extent, act as fixer to the ammonia in the soil as it may be formed, at contact with the atmosphere, preserve the soil from being washed away, and furnish an inconsiderable quantity of soda and chlorine for their appropriation.

**Outs.**—As soon as the frost is out of the ground, is the proper time to sow outs. We know 2400 bushels to be taken off of a 40 acre field; but that field was in good heart, had been limed and ashed, and a clover ley had been turned under to give place to the outs.

**The Farmer's Curio.**—We believe in small farms and thorough culture. We believe in large crops, which leave the land better than they found it.

**Destroying Weeds.**—A water of much experience gives this view as to the best mode of destroying weeds, which prove so great a pest to many otherwise excellent farms. He has tried every conceivable mode. Cutting off and hoeing out he has repeated over and over again, without the least success—as the more he cut and hoed the more they sprang up. But finally, he put the ground in with clover, thickly down. The weeds sprang next season as usual, but they were sickly; sleep were then torn in the pasture on the clover—and that as the complete extinction of the weeds. This is an easy mode for most farmers to try the water is confident that clover is the great enemy of the briar and a sure exterminator.

**Steaming Corned Food.**—An English Farmer, who keeps 50 head of cattle and horses, estimates that he saved thirty tons of hay in one year, by chopping and steaming a mixture of equal parts of hay and straw, and saving \$270 worth of hay. The cost of cutting and steaming was less than \$20.
