BULLOCK, late of the township of Wyalusing, has been killed by a falling log, in consequence of the explosion of a barrel of blasting powder, which he was using in the excavation of a well on his farm, near the village of Rome, Bradford County, Pa. The deceased was a native of New York, and had resided in this county for many years. He was a very industrious and successful farmer, and was well known to all his neighbors. His death is a great loss to his family, and to the community in general. The cause of the accident is believed to have been the carelessness of the deceased in handling the blasting powder.
