How to Make a Good Barnyard.

Several things are essential to render a barnyard a good one. It must be so constructed that water from any source will not accumulate in it.

The next step is to grade the yard, either by hauling and leveling off, or by cutting a ditch to carry off the surplus water that will be liable to find its way among the manure.

How to Increase the Manure Pile.

The soil unmanured, will often produce good crops for a year or two, or more, and then it demands the aid of manure to recuperate, and gain soluble, and nutritious elements.

Manures supply to the soil what the plants require as food, and that which other crops have removed. They also cause chemical action to take place, by means of which plant-food, in the soil but not available to the plant, becomes soluble, or otherwise available.

In all civilized countries in which the soil has been long enough under cultivation to show a decline in fertility, manure is valued for all the reasons just enumerated.

It is now autumn, and our friend will not do well to collect much, if any, vegetable matter which can contain weed seeds in any considerable quantity.

Best Method for Keeping Beef.—Cut up the meat in pieces as large as you desire. Pack it in a barrel, or cask. Then make a brine as follows: 1 1/2 lbs. salt to 1 gallon water, 1 oz. saltpetre to 100 lbs. of beef.

Another good way to keep meat.—Cut it in slices ready to broil or fry for the table. Then putting down in a jar one layer of meat, sprinkle with salt and pepper, and so continue till the jar is filled, cover closely and set in the coolest part of the cellar.
