To Pickle Pluns — Eor eight pounds of fruit take four pounds of sugar, two quarts of vinegar, one ounce cinnamon, and one of cloves; boil the vinegar, sugar, and spices together; skim and pour scalding hot over your fruit; Let it set three days; pour off the syrup, scald and skim and pour over again, and continue this process every three days till you have scalded it tree times, a ter which it will be fit for use. Plums prepared in this way, we think superior to the old method of preserving with sugar alone.
