In other places it is of great advantage to place rye meal in shallow vessels near the bees every pleasant day, as a substitute for pollen. They gather it eagerly, and rear brood much earlier for having it. If no etream or brook is near your bees, provide them with water in some way; they need it specially in spring, and many are lost if they go far to obtain it.—Rural World.
