

Agricultural.
Clover
One of our best farmers called upon the other day, and requested us to call attention to our paper to the fact that among the tall grasses none was as profitable as clover. It grows so rank that a crop of it, if cut under, is of more value as fertilizer than a good cutting of ordinary manure. Its roots strike so deep that it flourishes well on dry land, and yet it grows better and stronger on moist land as do nearly all grasses. It is of such rank growth that, if itself, it overtops and drives from the soil the weaker grasses and weeds. Sown, a great pest to soil, it is said to be effectively driven out by clover. If farmers would make a good stand they would well apply a small coat of plow of Paris early in the spring. This is an excellent absorbent, and retains escaping ammonia better than almost any other cheap fertilizer. For a summer and fall feed it grows more rapidly and keeps green later than any other grass. Those who would have short winters can make their comparative, by sowing a field of clover for fall feeding. The frosts come to it later, by reason of the thick leaves that protect the stalks than to any other grass. Cattle will not only thrive but fat on it. Butter made from milk of cows kept on this feed is equally as rich and sweet, made in November, as upon ordinary feed in June or September. Recently we saw an article in an agricultural paper where a farmer in southern Ohio recommended clover pastures for hogs. He said that two acres of clover would equal in value to one of good growing and the hogs healthy, growing and fat, all the time. The strong roots kept the ground loose, and the hogs would work among them and so find their food above and below ground. It is an excellent manure, and should have a place to sow, and mature to yellow in, as that it should have proper food. In clover fields ordinarily all are found. Clover can be put in with wheat, buckwheat, oats, and almost any crop that is scattered broadcast. Cattle should not be turned upon it the first year. If one would only sow clover for the purpose of growing hay it is well to sow both timothy or red-top with it, and the timothy comes in best about the second year and red top the third. For stock that is only kept for work or growth, probably either as good as clover. The great advantage that the farmer in cultivating this kind of grass will find will be in the fact that it grows a heavy crop in good land, is excellent for hogs, cows and growing stock, and is the best feed for sheep and young cattle in winter. It has the soil rich if plowed under.
