Bots.  
FARMER ALVORD: Seeing an article in your paper about bots in horses, I would state that I have had the worst of cases and the medicine I give never fails to cure.  
1. If the bots are at work in the stomach, the horse will not droop, his head will be up, and he will be very nervous. Then I take a quart of sage and put it in three quarts of water and if you have not some of the same quantity of ordinary tea will do as well and pour it down him as warm as you can without scalding.  
2. If the bots are back the horse will droop, his head will be down, and he will be very nervous. Then I take one quart of alcohol and two quarts of manure, mix them well together, and add one quart of rain water; then shake a lump of white chalk the size of a thimble in it, take a good bowl, draw up his head and pour it down him. If that does not cure, repeat the dose in three hours. After giving this, let the horse roll and tumble all he will before you repeat, and after.

**The Absorbent Power of Soil.**  
It is an important discovery of recent date, that soils have the power of absorbing, not only ammonia, but other bases also, from their solutions, and of holding them with great tenacity after absorption. Thus 100 grains of clay soil, taken from the plastic clay formation of England, absorbed 1,000 grains of potash from a solution of caustic potash containing one per cent. of the alkali. It is interesting to observe that the liquid was not in this case filtered through the soil, but the solid solution was merely left in contact with it for three hours.  
It has been further shown that soils have the ability to separate the alkaline bases from the acids with which they are combined. When saline solutions were slowly filtered through soils five or six inches deep, the liquids which passed through were deprived of their alkaline bases, as potash, soda, ammonia, and magnesia, and only the acids were to be found in combination with some of the elements. Thus when muriatic acid was removed, and a corresponding quantity of lime, in combination with muriatic acid, was found in the filtered liquid. In the same way sulphate of lime on analysis.  
Those soils which have the greatest amount of capillary property will divide up the soil into the smallest particles, and thus the most porous, and will retain their longest against the adverse solvent action of water; and will give their out most readily to the roots of the growing plant. A mass of adhesive clay will absorb but a very slight amount of available moisture; but if the mechanical processes, its power of absorption is amazingly increased. In view of what has been stated, it is very clear that one way in which ploughing increases the fertility of land, is by increasing its porosity by pulverization. Again, many manual substances exist in the soil, which, being insoluble, exercise no action on the growth of plants, and contribute nothing to their nutrition; but by the soil, through regular action of the frosts and rains, the air and sunshine, insoluble and refractory compounds are appropriated and held on deposit by the soil to the credit of the next crop. This explains the well-known fact that soils, which have been cropped to the very verge of barrenness, will recover their fertility if allowed to remain long enough under the action of climatic influences, so that the soil will be enriched with the necessary plant food which they have unlocked from their chemical combinations, and given to the soil in a proper physical condition. These changes are brought about more rapidly when certain mechanical changes of condition are wrought upon the soil.  
Carbonic acid is one of the most active of the agents employed in bringing the insoluble organic matter in the soil into that physical condition in which it becomes available as plant food; in fact, this acid, as we have formed, it is essential that the carbonaceous matters in the soil should be brought into direct contact with the atmosphere, from which they procure the oxygen necessary to convert them into carbonic acid. So long as stagnant water remains in the soil, or so long as the soil is in a dense or a very compact condition, it is impossible for the carbon to be converted into acid.—Boston Journal of Chemistry.

**HAYMAKING**—Haymaking is almost at hand. The grass will be fit to cut in less than a fortnight. Farmers are already preparing for the busy season. There is nothing like being ready for the important summer's work. Then everything works smoothly, and the business of getting in the crops has little "worry" or trouble about it.  
There is a time to cut grass so as to preserve it rich and succulent in its condition in the stack; and there is a time to cure hay that makes it worth twice as much to cattle as that cut too early or too late, and fully cured. It should be the study of the farmer to get in his crops just in the nick of time when the grain and the grass are exactly ready for the harvest. To do this it is necessary to be prepared.

**KROGON COWS**—Hearing one of our neighbors very recently came near losing his life by a kicking cow. I send the following preventative hoping it may fall under his observation: Procure a leather strap about three feet long with buckles on it, having them placed nearest to one end, each to buckle on opposite ends, buckle the short end around the knee just above the foot, bend the knee so the foot will touch the leg close to the body; pass the long end of the strap around the leg and buckle it. Then sit down on a stool, place your knee against her hind leg, and put her tail under your arm, and you have her in a position where she cannot kick to harm, or spoil your Sunday clothes.—Kennet Leader.

**A RELISH FOR BREAKFAST** OR LUNCHEON.—Take a quarter of a pound of cheese, good and fresh; cut it up in thin slices, and put it in a "spider," turning over it a large cupful of sweet milk; add a quarter of a teaspoonful of dry mustard, a dash of pepper, a little salt, and a piece of butter as large as a butterer; stir the mixture over, and sprinkle them in gradually; as soon as they are stirred in, turn out the contents into a warm dish and serve.
