THE COCONUT GRAPE. Objections are frequently made to the Concorde grape, on account of its acidity. This is very easily accounted for by the fact that too much fruit is allowed to grow upon the vines. The ideas sometimes advanced, that the vine of fruit should not be pruned at all, has been proved incorrect by the experience of the most practical vine dressers. This variety has been fully tested as a table grape, and its superior merits have been demonstrated. If it is properly cultivated it is the best for general culture, and takes the lead in vigor and adaptability of any that is now grown in the open air in this section of the country. Vines that have been planted four years, and are perfectly healthy and vigorous, will, if rightly pruned, bear from forty to sixty bushels of grapes annually. One-half of the crop should be removed soon after the fruit sets. By this method the fruit will ripen some two or three weeks in advance of vines upon which all of it is allowed to grow. Older vines will produce a similar result under the same treatment. To improve the flavor of the fruit place it on earthenware in a well ventilated cellar for several weeks. By this means its acid properties will be changed, and it will then have more of the saccharine matter, which is a most desirable quality. To grow the fruit for fresh use in this way be kept perfectly fresh for two or three months. It will be found that this grape can be grown in this manner with a fair prospect of profit to those who cultivate it for the market, as its value would be greatly increased. It would find a quick sale to those who are usually inclined to pay a fair price for choice fruit, rather than purchase that of an inferior quality at a cheaper rate. Here, then, is one important requirement to grow first-class fruit.

INSUREANCE OF HEAT ON PLANTS - The result of a recent investigation by Biaboloch, in regard to the influence of the warmth of soil upon the development of certain cultivated plants, is summed up by him in the following words: The influence of warmth of the soil is to manifest in two directions: in the shortening or lengthening of the period of germination, and in affecting the external form of the plant: the acceleration of growth of vegetation occurring principally in the earlier periods. With an ascending temperature of the soil, germination is forwarded up to a certain point. From the moment, however, when this point is reached an increase of temperature in the soil actually retards growth. The maximum point of favorable temperature of the soil is that at which the period of germination is the longest; and the maintenance of a constant temperature has for its result a more vigorous growth of the plant.
