NEW CONSTITUTION PROPOSED TO THE CITIZENS OF BRADFORD COUNTY.
THEIR APPROVAL OR REJECTION BY THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION.
Published by order of the Secretary of the Commonwealth, in pursuance of the 4th section of an act of the General Assembly, entitled "An Act to provide for calling a Convention to amend the Constitution," approved the 11th day of April, A. D. 1872.

DECLARATION OF RIGHTS.
That the great and essential principles of liberty and justice, under the Constitution, are hereby declared to be the basis of the Government, and that no law shall be enacted which shall violate these principles.

ARTICLE I.
Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in a Senate and House of Representatives, which shall be chosen by the people of this State.

ARTICLE II.
Section 1. The executive power shall be vested in a Governor, who shall be chosen by the people of this State.

ARTICLE III.
Section 1. The judicial power shall be vested in a Supreme Court and such inferior courts as may be established by the General Assembly.
