

## Agricultural Department

### Orchard and Nursery.

Care and attention are constantly required. The careless leaving of a gate open or a fence down may result in great damage to the young trees from the depredations of cattle. While shutting out the stock of others, properly shut in your own.

Also and rabbits need to be looked after to light snow. Trump down the snow around the trees, to head off the mice, and sprinkle blood upon the trunks to keep the rabbits away. If pruning is to be done, attend to it before the buds swell, to give the air to reach all parts of the tree. When the orchard is cultivated, the heads will have to be kept higher to allow the teams to pass under them. Successors should be cut off, and as soon as the weather will allow, the ground directly around the trees should be broken up, and the moss and dead bark removed by soft soap wash.

Manure may be hearted to the orchard at this season and spread or placed in heaps. It can be hauled at this season of the year on sleds. Labels will be needed for the newly set trees, and should be prepared beforehand. Large nursery labels are best made out of red cedar; if this wood is not convenient, pine or chestnut will last a few years, but cedar is the cheapest in the end.

Show the buyers how to make a correct plan of the orchards and nursery; on this should be indicated the correct position and name of every tree; this will be found the only way to preserve the names where an orchard is planted with several varieties.

**WHEN TO BREED OUR COWS.**—In answer to this question, we have only time now to observe (as we intend to discuss it more fully hereafter), that full calves are usually more profitable than those dropped in spring. The old notion that the cow should come in on grass originated when it was the practice to keep cattle the year around on grass and hay alone, and as grass was more nutritious than hay, and especially better for the calf, the practice prevailed of breeding for spring calves. But it is now well understood that the cow fresh in milk can be profitably milked out, and that to prevent the running down that always results, especially with good milkers, such feed ought to be given. And the same is true with regard to the calf. As soon as it is old enough to eat, shorts or meal and bran should be given, and will be far better for the young calf than grass. But the great point is, that a calf dropped in spring, especially in October or November, will be old enough to be milked out on fresh grass in the spring, and to have the full benefit of the next summer's grazing, which will make it fully equal to winter to a June or July calf of the previous year. Besides, as good farmers now so generally stable their stock in winter, the feeding of the cows and calves is of no inconsequence. Farmers using upon these suggestions will see that such is the time to purchase your bulls. The common notion of waiting till spring is the wrong notion. They can be had cheaper now, and, acting upon the above suggestion, you will want them for use during the winter.—*Live Stock Journal.*

**THE BEST FEED BEANS.**—The American Rural Home says that in Western New York the Medium and Marrow are most planted and the White Kidney and Early Pea are the limited extent. The Medium is considered the most reliable, as from its ripening it is less affected by the vicissitudes of the season. It sells for less, however than the other varieties named. The Marrow is quite a popular variety, and on a strong soil is very productive. It is quoted thirty-five cents a bushel higher than Medium in the Rochester market, and the same as Kidney. The White Kidney has longer stalks, requires a longer season to be matured, and is more liable to be spotted in ripening. When everything, however, is favorable it will produce large crops. It will, of course, make a difference in what way the beans are planted as to the quality of seed required, but farmers generally use about a bushel of the Marrow, and Medium to the acre, rather more of the Kidney, and about half as much of the Pea bean.

**THE WAY TO ST FOWLES.**—I have reared fowls of all sorts for more than forty years, and have always found that it is the better way to have a small apartment in some building appropriated to some ducks, and turkeys where they may not be molested during incubation. When a female bird is liable to be driven from her nest by other fowls that are seeking a place to lay, many of the eggs are liable to be trampled under the feet of the fowls, and the eggs are really lost. As soon as a few are really hatched, to incubate, a nice nest is made for her in a half-barrel tub, or soap box, the eggs marked with a pencil, placed in the nest, and, evening, the hen is duck taken out, and put on the prepared nest and the tub carried into the sitting apartment. Water and some feed are kept in this apartment, so that a bird may not be required to leave her nest for a long time in search of food.

**FINE AND COARSE HAY.**—Producers are sometimes puzzled to know why city buyers generally ask for coarse well-manured hay in preference to the more tender and in reality more nutritious kinds. The Live Stock Journal, this enlightens them: City men feed hay for different purposes than the farmer. The farmer feeds it for his nutriment and as a principal food, while the city man regards grain the cheapest food and only gives sufficient hay for the purpose of health. Coarse well matured timothy serves the purpose better than the coarsest hay, while the city man does not desire such hay as will tempt the horse to eat too much of it. Straw would answer this purpose if cut and mixed with the grain about a couple of young folks get to have what they want all the time at a half and have no quantities that a sign that they are not to be taken to the city man is made plain.

### EDUCATION SUPERINTENDENT

As the triennial convention of school directors is but a few weeks distant, we give a list of the candidates for county superintendent, thus far announced, with a brief statement of their qualifications for the office. In the present status of affairs it is hard to tell the "inside track" for an election, but it is gratifying to know that so many eminently qualified teachers offer their services. We measure them to secure a list. Directors ought not to pledge themselves beforehand on account of friendship for particular parties merely, but meet unbiassed and make the best possible choice for the interests of common school education. This office ought to be entrusted to one of the best teachers, and we hope the directors will vote against any candidate who considers his name and reputation an insufficient recommendation, without a personal canvass on his part, begging for votes. The candidates thus far named are as follows:

1. To live religiously.  
2. To think comprehensively.  
3. To reason mathematically.  
4. To converse fluently.  
5. To write grammatically.

Messrs. Edwards.—A report of the debate at the last meeting of the Association, represents me as opposing the increase of salary of County Superintendent, on the ground that the pay is already large enough for the capital invested. As this statement is susceptible of misinterpretation, please give this explanation a place in your column. The argument advanced was substantially as follows:

"Money invested in education should not be invested in a higher rate of interest or profit, than when invested in land or in any legitimate line of business." Nature has given all men a certain amount of capital to start with; their capacity to perform physical labor, and by the necessary laws of our existence, the cultivation of the soil is the basis upon which rest all other forms of industry. Starting from these well established facts, and supposing that the average man can earn \$320 per annum, by physical labor, and that the profits of a farm represent one per cent. a year, skill, education and culture ought not to receive, in addition to this, more than the annual interest on the amount which the individual has invested in that skill, education and culture. Applying this test to the question of the superintendent's salary, the following we believe to be a fair statement:

CAPITAL INVESTED, EQUIVALENT SALARY.  
Natural capital, \$5,000 66 2/3  
Education, 2,000 00  
Culture, 1,000 00  
Total, \$8,000 66 2/3  
Interest at 4% 320 00  
Wear and tear, 40 00  
Total, \$360 00

That is to say the able-bodied man who has no more education than the average first class college graduate if elected superintendent should not complain if the directors fix his salary at \$700 per annum. \$1,000 should equitably call for average physical health and more than \$1,000 invested in culture and skill. It seems to me the convention will think twice before they increase salary and in a ready liberal.

A good teacher will also perpetually study the mental habits of his pupils, and try to learn in what things each is most deeply interested. Every opportunity to overhear the talk of children with one another, and note their characteristic ways of "putting things," should be improved. If the teacher can learn what particular thing any child is deeply concerned in, and get him to talk to him on paper about it, he may secure a genuine composition. The instruction about writing should be a feeling after these topics of vital interest to the scholar, and the encouragement of the most natural and characteristic way of setting forth his ideas and feelings about it. Errors in spelling and handwriting of course should always be noticed. The grammatical correction is a matter of far greater importance; for we are convinced that, in a majority of cases, the natural style of a child is destroyed in the effort to reduce his performance to a formal grammatical propriety.—A.
