The three great ideas are (1) the freedom and independence of the Spirit-" bloweth where it listeth;" (2) the irresistible effect--"thou hearest the sound thereof: (3) the incomprehensibili ty--"thou knowest not"-both as to origin' ("whence it cometh") and to termination ("whither it goeth "). "So it is with every one that is born of the Spirit." Nicodemus could not understand this mystery; v. 9. This ignorance was a reproach (v. 10), as this doctrine is sufficiently indicated in the Old Testament to prepare a teacher of Israel for the fuller revelations of the Gospel. But the trouble arose not from mere inability to comprehend, but from unbelief (v. 11). "If I have told you earthly things," - the truths concerning salvation viewed from its carthly side (of which regeneration is one)-"and ye believe not, how shall ye believe if I tell you of heavenly things ?" -i. e., of the truths concerning salvation viewed from the heavenly side-the eternal plan of God for man's redemption, of which he goes on to treat, and especially in v. 16. It is true that if any one rejects the doctrine of regeneration, he will reject the doctrine also of vicarious atone-

ment. And to reject the witness of Jesus Christ is to reject the only competent witness of heavenly things (v. 13); because he, and he alone, unites a divine and human nature in his person-he was at the same time on earth and in heaven, As thus Son of man and Son of God, he is the revealer of God's mysterious counsels concerning the redemption of the world. And what God's plan of salvation is he goes on to state: vs. 14-17.
