OUR RURAL SCHOOLS.

That considerable progress has been made during the last two decades in our public schools, located in cities and large towns, is generally conceded. It is true that the progress was not uniform. In some of our rural schools, the salaries paid the teachers and in the efficiency of the schools, few would answer in the affirmative. The reasons are apparent. Present among them is the fact that the rate of taxation which in the country would give an inadequate amount for the support of a good school, in the town swells up to the thousands. Nor in a large number of cases do our farmers feel like paying a sufficient sum to procure the best teachers, or to build the finest buildings. To no class of taxpayers does money come harder or more slowly. Men who handle large amounts of money attach less value to what they do have and are more liberal in expending it than those who work hard for what they have and through whose hands a smaller amount passes, even though the actual gain be the same. In consequence of the above and other reasons, finer buildings have been erected and more experienced and better qualified teachers have been employed in towns and cities. And we must expect to see them continue to go where they can obtain the best remuneration. The question then arises what are we to do for our schools in the country? Must our children who have clear minds—thanks to pure air and vigorous exercise—have inferior advantages? Teachers who command large wages will be quite sure to go where they can obtain them, and the rural schools will largely be left to the inexperienced and those who, having experience, have not profited by it. That the work of a tyro will be inferior to the work of a skilled workman, who has gone through his apprenticeship, needs no comment. The only question remaining is, how are we to make the best use of the teachers who we have in our country schools and must of necessity expect to have when our directors open their hearts and pay their female teachers the magnificent sum of ten dollars a month, with the privilege of boarding around. Of course it is expected that directors paying such liberal salaries will use harsh language and find fault if the teacher is not well qualified and does not evince ability in the conduct of her school. Of course, with this remunerative salary to look forward to and employment from one-quarter to one-half the year, it will pay her to qualify herself. Why should not the "schoolmaster" for it is she who is elected to fill vacancies where these large salaries are offered, lay aside a handsome sum every month, to attend a school of "higher grade" during a part of the year? Nay, Keweenaw says their grade should be raised every year on their certificates if they are live teachers. But enough of this side of the picture. The teacher who is more interested in the work than in the money, who is more careful and frequent supervision. Parents afford the best material heaven has furnished for teachers to work upon. They have great interests at stake, should, by personal visits and knowledge, know what kind of work is being done. Their presence will be a stimulus, helpful and advantageous to both teacher and student. Especially should directors know whom they are employing. This is one of the most thankless and yet important offices in the gift of the people. Sufficient remuneration should be given these officers to indemnify them against loss of time in visiting schools and attending to other business necessary to the well being of our schools.

We must have a more careful supervision over rural schools. In Europe the officers superintending schools are much more plentiful than in this country. In a county as large as Bradford, at best the superintendent will seldom visit the schools. More help, then, is needed in this important field of school work. Each township should select its best qualified director to visit all the schools at least twice every session. The expense to the town would be small, the benefit derived would be large. Nor will better schools be the only good result accruing from a strict supervision of our schools. The directors will become acquainted with the teachers. Merit can then be rewarded, or at least ought to be. For teachers, as well as good, will soon be known to the directors. Then we might hope that teachers would be selected according to known ability, not according to priority of application.

Another desired consummation is that a broad difference should be made in the pay of good teachers and poor ones. Between a successful experience and a teacher as yet untried. The peculiar common school law of Pennsylvania in respect to employing teachers and determining their compensation has a direct and almost potent influence in driving merit and in placing good, poor and indifferent upon the same level so long as they teach in rural schools. In states where each district is independent, ample opportunity is afforded not only to recognize superior merit in a good teacher, by paying him an adequate salary, but also to encourage enterprise and a desire for better educational advantages among the citizens themselves. Until ability and a better grade of preparation is recognized by more adequate salaries, we cannot expect to see young men anxious to spend their hard earned dollars in a thorough preparation to teach, nor can we expect to see them remaining long in the business.

At the Educational Association, held at Richmond, by the negroes of the State, resolutions were adopted—inviting the whites to co-operate with the colored people in securing good schools and preventing truancy, and collecting important educational statistics. The chief speakers favored compulsory education, and a poll-tax of a dollar on all voters.
