IN 1872 THE IMPORTATION OF FOREIGN MERCHANDISE IN 1874 (GOLD VALUATION) WAS \$435,688,404, or at the rate of \$11.30 per capita of population, and in 1873 they were \$625,592,977.

THE ENTIRE CIRCULATION IN 1870 WAS, in round numbers, \$62,000,000, or 1873, \$745,000,000, and in 1874 it was \$788,800,000.

IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE CRASH OF 1873 COULD HAVE BEEN PRODUCED BY LACK OF SUFFICIENT CIRCULATING MEDIUM, when there were \$282,000,000 more in 1873 than in 1872, and in either year more than twice as much as in 1862!
