The cultivation of the basket-willow might be a profitable American industry. No less than two-thirds of the willow used in this country is imported from Europe.

JOLLY JELLY CAKE—Four eggs, white and yolks beaten separately, two teaspoonfuls baking powder, make in a dripping pan when done take the cake out and mix over on top with jelly or fruit and roll up carefully. It will not break.
