FOR THE INFORMATION OF THE PUBLIC.—A Fire Police was organized May 11th, auxiliary to the Fire Department. It is composed of S. M. BROWN, Captain; G. H. ESTELL, Lieutenant; A. J. HENNING, Treasurer; THOROUGH ANNOT, DANIEL M. WILSON, THOS. HENNING, A. D. COOPER, and CHARLES HANCOCK, privates. Their duties commence when an alarm of fire is given, and until discharged they have all the power of regular Borough Police.

Their duty is—1st. To save property removing what they may consider necessary to a safe place, and guard the same until the owner has reasonable time to care for it. 2nd. How to PUT ON NEW BOOTS ON SHOES.—A correspondent of the Philadelphia Ledger, has the following suggestions how to put on a new pair of boots or shoes, in order to prevent pain and suffering: "First select Sunday, (as the feet are more likely to have rest on this day). In the morning wash the feet in cold water, cut the nails, and corns if they are present, put on a soft, close-fitting stocking, introduce the foot slowly, if a new pair of boots or shoes are on hand, let them be introduced by a heavy gaiter, which will be experienced; this is aided by pressure on the vein interrupting the circulation. In about five minutes remove the boots or shoes, and with the rubber foot on both surfaces from the toes to the ankles; this will relieve the congestion and remove the creases from the stockings. If necessary, repeat this operation four or five times, and unless the person is attempting to put a No. 6 foot into a No. 5 foot, no great comfort will be the reward.
