THE "HALLS OF JUSTICE"—Officer Burns arrested and took before Justice TOWN on Tuesday evening last, District Attorney McPHERSON, E. E. BURNETT, and Charles HERRING, on a charge of fast driving in our streets.

After a hearing the District Attorney was discharged, on the ground, we understand, that his horse was not capable of exceeding the statute limiting the speed of horses on public thoroughfares to six miles per hour.

Messrs. BURNETT and HERRING, whose cases have not yet been disposed of, will appear in the morning, we suppose, the other parties will of necessity be discharged.

The resolutions presented to the Convention were not acted upon until Wednesday, and we are therefore unable to give them this week, but shall do so in our next issue, together with a more detailed account of the entire proceedings.

There was a free expression of opinion as to price per acre, desirability and usefulness of the grounds in question, but no definite action was taken, the managers being desirous of obtaining the views of all members of the society.

It would not be out of place for any persons who were members last year, to be present at that meeting, to give expression to their views on the subject, or if they cannot attend, to write to the secretary. All communications on the subject will be considered by the Board of Managers.

At the next meeting an Executive Committee will be chosen and the premium list will be revised.
