The Battle near Gettysburg.  
Wednesday, July 3.—An official dispatch was received this afternoon from Major General Meade, dated, Headquarters of the Army of the Potomac, 11 p. m., July 3, which says: "The army attacked me about four o'clock. The enemy attacked me from the rear of the Potomac, and I was killed and wounded. Among the killed were Brigadier General and Chief of Cavalry, Major General Buford, Major General Reynolds, Major General Sigbee, Major General Graham and various regiments. We have taken a large number of prisoners. A late dispatch has been received from Gen. Meade, dated 10 o'clock this morning, in which he says: "The action continued again at daylight upon various parts of the line. The enemy tried to break through the Potomac on my right, but I repulsed them with my artillery. They were again repulsed when they made a charge on my left. I have taken a large number of prisoners.
