To-day, at 10 o'clock, the National Convention of the Union League of Pennsylvania is in session at Wilkes Hall.

We referred, yesterday, to the wills of a republican caucus, and expressed the hope that Congress would, by the imposition of a tax sufficiently heavy, effect a complete reorganization of the paper issue with which the country is flooded.

This is a heavy tax, and must affect dividends to some extent; but as the circulation is taxed only 1/2 of 1 percent, it is questionable whether that portion of the tax will restrict the circulation at all, and whether the banks will not rather be stimulated, by the heavy taxation, to increase the earnings and keep up dividends.

And then, the tax falls upon the banks, but upon the National Bank, which has twice as much money as the other banks, and which, except that, the National bank, being retained as to its circulation, and unable to go beyond a certain limit, the State banks are left to their own devices.

We have seen that Congress, in establishing a National banking system, and fixing the limit of its issue at \$300,000,000, intended that system to supplant all others, and to be the sole issue of the country.

But, if it respects to any further legislation, it will frustrate its own intentions, and instead of giving us a healthy and independent National banking system, it will give us a system of State banks, with a National bank, which will be a mere appendage to the State banks.
