BOW NEW YORK FILLS HER QUGTA. The developments in New York show how that city and State have heretofore filled their quotas. What with bounty jumpers scenlisting half a dozon times, credits for naval enlistments that were never made, and firged certificates of enlistment got up to order, she has managed to get credit for an immense number of soldiers never furnished. Her quotas have been filled; but her regiments in the field remain the mere skeletons they were a year

ago, That game being now exposed, it is not likely an attempt to repeat it will be made ; but as the quots is to be filled in some more casy way than by delivering the roquired number of men, some new and easy method repust be found of dolging the draft. The President has been importuned into holding one fourth of the quota in abeyance; and now there is a vigorous amount of cyplicring going on to bring the figures of the quota down. The city, for instance, was found to be

growing with immense rapidity, up to the date of the last call; but since then it has been discovered that there are not near, so many anon there as had been supposed. A great many able bodied fellows between 20 and 45, who were out and able to vote two or three times at the Presidential election, cannot now be found, after the most careful seatch; and a thorough revision of the enrollment is demonstrating that New York is a much smaller city than Philadelphia, and that instead of growing and prospering, she is on the high road to run.
