He has taken through more than four thousand refugees, never losing but one man, and he was lost through his own in-discretion. The party, had lived eight or ten days, in winter, among the snowy mountsins, upon parched corn. (Dan de-clares that parched corn is say good to travel on as the most luxurious food, if a man only thinks so; but I feel bound to say that I have triftd if, and don't think so.) The man in question, finally revolted, and declared he would have an honist meal, if he got cap-tured. So he went to a house, obtained the meal, and did get captured. Early in the war, when our lines were at Louisville and Knoaville, Ellis conducted party after par-ity of refugees to those points, four and firo hundred miles through the Cumberland mountains.
