SHERMAN.

There is as much evidence now, to hear from Sherman as there was on that "pleasant" march of his from Atlanta to Savannah, but none of the history which he revealed. Then he was carrying out a dangerous experiment, with many odds against him, and fear almost extinguished hope. Now he is following a safer military policy, and besides, we have all now such full confidence in him that we feel sure he will come out all right, no matter what the odds may be against him.

Now, as then, his movements give all the ingenuity of the rebels. They cannot tell where he is going, or what he is doing. All they know is that he will straighten up, over all obstacles; and that whereas yesterday he was at Savannah, to-day he is at Charleston and Columbia, with an unobstructed road before him to the North.

In obtaining the points reached by him at left, advice, he has traversed one-third of the distance between Savannah and Wilmington, which includes the most difficult part of the road. The swamps of South Carolina are now in his rear, and his future progress will consequently be more rapid.

The fall of Charleston is regarded as a matter of course. With all his railroad communication severed, he is completely blocked, and the right wing of Sherman's army before him, the possibility of its holding out is not to be thought of. From there he has an easy march into North Carolina.

One fact is noticeable in all the accounts of his progress—he leaves no railroad behind him. He tears them up as he goes along, and if there is any fuel in them, he will not leave the benefit of railroad transportation in overhauling him.

It is our correspondent at Chattanooga writes, Hoon has been ordered to fight Sherman, he is several days left to the rear, completely. It is of no earthly importance to Sherman, and Hoon will have to get up very early every morning, he expects to do any fighting in South Carolina.

The rebels will find out after a while, if they have already, that Sherman is one too many for them.
