THE CLOSING OF SOUTHERN PORTS.

IMPORTANT CONCERNING FOREIGN NATIONS.

OUR RIGHTS MUST BE RESPECTED.

EQUALITY IN FOREIGN PORTS CLAIMED.

Ratification of Measures Threatened.

Washington, April 11.—The proclamation referred to in closing the Southern ports is in accordance with our original plan, and was then intended, "so far as it concerned foreign powers, would respect an effectual blockade of those ports, a claim of exclusive legal authority over them as other ports of the United States Government can claim to exercise that legal authority over all its ports, whether blockaded or not, which belongs to every independent sovereign power." A sufficient number of vessels, a force equal to that of the Amherst, and those now present, will, it is presumed, be required for that purpose. Meanwhile blockade running is still possible, though we anticipated a determined resistance we captured them with but little loss, with all the guns in them—securing eighteen cannons, and two mortars.
