Washington, Nov. 30, 1865.—An examination was made yesterday at the Treasury Department, by General Spinner, United States Treasurer, S. M. Clark, chief of bureau, and other able gentlemen. Sufficient information was gained by the experiment to set at rest the statement that the plate from which the counterfeit compound interest one-hundred-dollar notes were printed, was made from an impression taken from the genuine plate in the Treasury Department. The plate upon which the treasury Department prints the face of one-hundred-dollar compound-interest notes was made by taking the plate of a five per cent. legal-tender note and cutting out the sphere in the centre of the bill, and substituting for it a new device, containing the statement of the American Bank Note Compound-interest note is issued.
