Afternoon Dispatches.

Granby, Canada, April 23.

While a number of persons were congregated on the principal bridge at this place on Wednesday evening watching the flood, one end gave way precipitating eleven persons into the water. The river being very swift and the water unusually high, no assistance could be rendered the victims of the disaster, and the whole number were quickly carried out of sight and drowned.

Concord, April 23.

The greatest flood here since 1862. The Vermont, Central and Northern Railroad tracks are submerged, and mails and passengers are detained. A raft of 915,000 feet of logs, belonging to Mr. Barron, at White River junction, was carried away.
