Afternoon Dispatches.

Pittsburgh, May 3.

Saturday about noon a particularly sad and shocking affair occurred at Oakdale Station on the Pan Handle Railroad, about twelve miles from the city resulting in the death, about an hour after, of a little boy aged nine years, son of Samuel Leibel, senior, and the wounding of an other son a year or two older. They were slaying themselves by firing off caps on a pistol, when one of the boys found three shots which he placed in his pistol, and fired in the direction of the others, the shot taking effect in the brain of one, producing death in an hour, and seriously wounding the other in the arm.
